## Steveston Japanese Language School / G&F Financial Group Scholarship

The Steveston Japanese Language School offers scholarship funds sponsored by the G&F Financial Group.

Two scholarship funds per year, in the amount of \$350 each, are available for qualified students who attended the Saturday High School (Intermediate) Level Classes to apply.

### Purpose of the Scholarship

1. To assist the student with his/her post secondary education.
2. To encourage the student to continue his/her Japanese language studies at the school for as long as possible.
3. To further the student's interest in Japanese language.
4. To assist the parents/guardians of the student as a token of appreciation for their support of the school for many years while the student attended the school.

### Eligibility - Who can apply?

1. The student is a high school graduate who will be attending an accredited post secondary institution such as university, college or technical institution.
2. The student has completed at least 4 years at the Intermediate level (Saturday classes) between levels 1 and 5.
3. The student must apply within two years of graduating from high school.

### Other criteria for consideration after the applicant meet the above eligibility

1. The student has attained an above average scholastic achievement in his final year of high school. A transcript from high school should accompany the applicant.
2. The student is a "good to outstanding" student at the Steveston Japanese Language School with good attendance record. The history of report cards from school files at the Steveston Japanese Language School will be reviewed by the principal and the scholarship committee.
3. The student exhibits capability of leadership and respect from his peers.
4. The student submits the letter-style personal resume which includes the information of extra-curricular activities such as sports, music, dance, community service, work, etc.
5. Proof of registration at the post-secondary school must accompany the application.

## Application for the scholarship

1. Students may pick up application forms from the school office or download off the school website sjls.ca.
2. The application form with necessary credentials should be returned to the attention of the principal of the Steveston Japanese Language school after enrolment into the post secondary school in order for the committee to review the applications.
3. Applications must be received by September 15.
